The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.177 dated 05.10.2016 for the offence under Sections 307, 376, 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties and the quashing petition is pending for 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-7).
