INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Mangat Ram alias Manga Pehlwan has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.14 dated 26.01.2016, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 308, 323, 324, 325, 326, 341, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that though the present petitioner has been named in the FIR and has been stated to be armed with *kirpan*, but

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no injury has been attributed to him in the FIR. However, learned State counsel has stated that a simple injury has been attributed to the present petitioner on the right leg of Rajender Singh. The main accused in the present FIR is Rakesh.

The petitioner has been in custody since 14.12.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
