The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.60 dated 15.04.2016 for the offence under Sections 304-B, 302, 306 IPC, registered at Police Station C Division, District Amritsar City.

The petitioner is husband of the deceased and he is in custody since 18.04.2016. A perusal of supplementary challan (Annexure P-4) shows that offence under Section 306 IPC is made out against the petitioner but charges have been framed against the petitioner under Section 304 B and 302 IPC. It is informed by the learned State counsel that out of 27 witnesses, 13 witnesses have been examined.

Keeping in view of the above and after going through the cross-examination of the complainant and considering the fact that trial is not likely to mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Amritsar.
