Petitioner-Anmol has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.305 dated 22.12.2016, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot, under Sections 379A and 379B of Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR in the present case has been got registered at the instance of Loveleen Kaur. As per the allegations, on 21.12.2016, when she was going on rickshaw, 3 boys on splendor motorcycle started following her rickshaw and snatched her bag containing laptop, one mobile phone, one purse, one identity card, one cheque for an amount of Rs.5000/-, ATM card, Aadhaar Card, licence, 5 Jio Sims, RC of Activa, two pen-drives (8 G.B.) and some other documents. In the present petition, two of the co-accused have already been arrested and the present petitioner has been named by those co-accused.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
