As per the office report, respondent No.5 has been served but he has not turned up.

Petitioner – Parvesh Kumari has filed the instant petition with a prayer to issue directions to Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot and Station House Officer, Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Pathankot (respondents No.2 to 4) to take necessary action against respondents No.5 to 11, namely, M.C. Veenu Sharma, Davinder Sharma alias Banti, Deepu, Shinder, Surinder Kumar alias Lucky, Shama and Raju and to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from such private respondents.

It is contended that respondents No.3 and 4 in active connivance with respondents No.5 to 11 used to take brother of the

petitioner to some unknown place and after giving beatings to him left him outside the house. Despite various representations being submitted, no action has been taken in the matter by the higher authorities. As a matter of fact on 4.5.2016 at about 8:00 p.m., respondents No.7 to 11 having weapons had trespassed in the house of the petitioner causing injuries to her brother, namely, Ganesh Kumar and damaged the household articles. The motive for the incident was that respondents No.7 to 11 are drug addicts and they used to take intoxicants and the petitioner would object to their doing so. Some other incidents are also narrated in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to inquire into the matter and take necessary action.

Accordingly, respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot is directed to look into the grievances of the petitioner contained in representations Annexure P1 to Annexure P4 and to take necessary action in the matter, which is warranted by facts and circumstances of the case within a period of two months from today. The petitioner be joined in the inquiry, which may be conducted by respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot himself or got conducted through some gazetted police officer.
