INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Paramvir Singh has filed this petition under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.113 dated 14.08.2016, registered at Police Station Maqsoodan, District Jalandhar, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that it is a case of version and cross-version. The petitioner side has also got registered an FIR under Section 302 IPC against the complainant party. The grievous injury on the back of hand has been attributed to the present petitioner.

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In pursuance of the interim order dated 02.03.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the facts that it is stated to be a case of version and cross-version and it is yet to be decided on the basis of evidence by the trial court as to who is the aggressor party, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 02.03.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
