This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.111 dated 16.09.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Boota Singh is the brother-in-law of the complainant and he has been declared as proclaimed offender. The petitioner is also the party to the compromise (Annexure P-2)

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that vide order dates 23.08.2016, petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender and a compromise in the present case has been executed on 14.06.2016 and petitioner has done his signature to the compromise deed.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State**

of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Cr1.) 1052, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Keeping in view that the complainant has now re-married and has accepted the terms of the compromise (Annexure P-2) and dispute between the complainant and petitioner is compoundable in nature, FIR No.111 dated 16.09.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
