On 14.03.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in order to show his bona fide, petitioner is ready to deposit an amount of Rs.2.5 lacs by means of demand draft in the name of the complainant.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer to join investigation on 20.03.2017 and also to submit demand draft in the sum of Rs.2.5 lacs in favour of the complainant. On doing so, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List on 09.05.2017.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation. An amount of Rs.2.5 lacs by way of demand draft has also been handed over to the Investigating Officer, which in turn has been handed over to the complainant.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh.

In view of above, interim order dated 14.03.2017 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
