Present revision petition has been filed after delay of 2130 days.

Learned counsel for the applicant while arguing on the point of delay contended that appeal was filed initially after delay of 18 days and some objections were raised by the registry. Thereafter, the documents were mis-placed by clerk of the counsel and in that process, the revision petition could not be filed in time and delay has been occurred. He prays for condoning the delay in filing the present revision.

Having considered these facts, this Court is of the considered view that there is no justification for condonation of delay of 2130 days on the ground of filing and re-filing the revision. The ground taken in the application is that, the lapse was on the part of clerk of the counsel is not justified.

The application for condonation of delay as well as the revision petition is dismissed.
