Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.62 dated 13.03.2015, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Prosecution has allegedly made a recovery of 55 bottles of Rexcof, 15 vials containing 100 tablets each and 30 injections Fortwin of 1 ml. each, a bag containing 150 grams of light green powder and a polythene containing 300 grams of white powder.

Report of the chemical examiner has already been received.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner very fairly concedes that the alleged recovery of contraband would be construed as commercial in nature.

This Court as such would not be inclined to grant in favour of the petitioner the concession of regular bail.

Petition dismissed.
