In FIR No.31 dated 18.06.2016, under Sections 326, 323, 324, 341, 342, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

I have seen the attribution to the petitioner-Pargat Singh. The allegations in the FIR clearly show that he repeatedly struck blows by means of *datar* resulting into serious injuries.

In that view of the matter, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
