Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over bank draft in the sum of ₹2,30,000/- dated 16.01.2017 to the learned counsel for respondent No.1 today in the Court itself. Copy of the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that earlier a sum of ₹1,10,000/- was paid to the complainant/respondent No.1. He has also contended that in terms of the compromise/settlement dated 25.07.2016 effected between the parties at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this

Court, the entire amount has been paid to complainant/respondent No.1.

This fact is also not denied by learned counsel for respondent No.1.

Since the parties have settled the matter amicably and the entire amount has been paid in terms of abovesaid compromise, so this revision petition stands accepted. The impugned judgments of conviction and order of sentence of the petitioner under challenge in this revision are also set aside. Complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act filed before the trial Court as a result thereof also stands dismissed.

This revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.
