TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Husband of the petitioner, namely, Karamjit Singh is an accused in FIR No. 51 dated 03.06.2016, under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149 IPC read with Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar Rural and is presently confined in Central Jail, Kapurthala.

In the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. counsel confines his prayer for issuance of appropriate directions to the Superintendent, Central Jail Kapurthala to get husband of the petitioner re-examined at Government Medical College, Amritsar. To support such prayer, counsel contends that husband of the petitioner Karamjit Singh had also suffered fire-arm injuries and by way of a surgical procedure carried out by doctors of the Government Medical College, Amritsar, some pellets had been removed from his body. It is contended that some more pellets still remain and on account of which husband of the petitioner is in constant pain and agony. Against such backdrop, it is contended that it is imperative

Amritsar by the concerned doctor.

In the light of such limited prayer and relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to issue notice and to get a response from the respondents.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits of the submissions advanced by the counsel, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition at the preliminary stage itself by granting liberty to husband of the petitioner, namely, Karamjit Singh to approach the Jail doctor/Superintendent, Central Jail Kapurthala as regards his grievance and who in turn would be obligated to take further steps as warranted in accordance with law.
