The petitioners have filed a petition seeking quashing of FIR No. 97 dated 1.2.2017 registered at police station, Gurgaon City, District Gurgaon for offence punishable under Sections 363, 366-A of the Indian Penal Code (in short "IPC") with regard to kidnapping of Neetu Sharma.

The complainant has not been arrayed as a respondent when otherwise, the matter is premature being under investigation.

That being so, the present petition stands disposed of but without prejudice to right of the petitioners to file a fresh petition after presentation of challan, if need be. However, respondent No. 2 is directed to appear before the investigating officer for recording her statement and the investigating officer shall record her statement, in accordance with law. She may furnish her affidavit before the investigating officer.
