Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have married each other against the wishes of respondents No.3 to 6 and on account of this act on their part, they are under threat of being eliminated at the hands of respondents No. 3 to 6. In view of the above, seeking protection, a representation dated 28.02.2017 (Annexure P-5) was made on behalf of the petitioners to the Superintendent of Police, Mewat, but to no avail.

In the above circumstances, the petitioners have approached this Court through the present petition.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, particularly the validity of the alleged marriage and the age of the petitioners as projected by them in the present petition, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Mewat (respondent No.2) to forthwith consider the aforesaid representation
