**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.61 dated 15.10.2016, under Sections 379/328 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

Petitioner has already faced incarceration in excess of two months against the allegations of having stolen 04 buffaloes, Rs.10,000/- from the complainant as also two mobile phones.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan stands presented. Charges are yet to be framed.

The trial as such would take time to conclude.

Even though State counsel would oppose the instant petition by submitting that there are three other cases registered against the petitioner but it has gone unrebutted that the petitioner is on bail in the other criminal proceedings.

It may be noticed that even the present FIR was against

own disclosure suffered during the course of investigation of a different FIR.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail. Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
