The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 83 dated 9.11.2016 under Sections 376(2)(n), 323, 368, 506 of the Indian Penal Code (in short "IPC") registered at Police Station, Women Hisar.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the prosecutrix has already been examined and has failed to support the prosecution. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State would concede to this position that the prosecutrix has not supported cause of the prosecution.

In view of the above, without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the controversy, bail to the petitioner subject to satisfaction of the trial court. However, he shall abide by the following

conditions:-

(i)He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and

(ii)He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
