This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.321 dated 13.09.2016 registered under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Ambala, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the present FIR under Section 174-A has been lodged for non-appearance in the complaint case titled as "Cholamandal Vs.Nayab Ali" and that the petitioner has already paid the entire loan amount to the complainant. The complainant, on receipt of payment has also issued No Objection Certificate and withdrawn the complaint. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is not named in any other FIR.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.
