The petitioner prays for grant of bail in anticipation of arrest in FIR No.45 dated 25.07.2016 registered at Police Station G.R.P., Chandigarh for offence punishable under Sections 363, 365 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Counsel for the petitioner would submit that though the petitioner is a resident of Malout but he has nothing to do with the complainant or Harpreet Kaur with whom the complainant allegedly got married on 03.05.2016. It is further submitted that though in the FIR there is reference to Gora resident of City Malout but no further particulars of said Gora have been mentioned and on that account, the petitioner is being harassed in connection with the FIR lodged by Atma Ram.

Sh. Lajpat Sharma, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of the complainant. Affidavit of the complainant filed in the Court is taken on record. He has conceded to the position that petitioner is not

the person named in the FIR lodged at the behest of complainant - Atma Ram.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is allowed anticipatory bail with a direction that in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail by the investigating officer subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (iii) He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.
