By this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, who was earlier on bail but on account of his not appearing before the learned trial Court, his bail bonds were forfeited on 9.12.2016.

In the aforesaid circumstances, I see no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail. The petition is consequently dismissed.

However, upon him surrendering before the trial Court and presenting an application for 'regular bail', it would be decided expeditiously by that Court, on its own merits.
