Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is the owner of truck bearing registration No.PB-10-FB-9295. A minor accident took place when the driver of the truck namely Baljit Singh was driving the truck on 10.12.2016. There was no physical harm to anyone, nor there was any property loss caused by that accident. Only DDR was registered by the police on the complaint of one Jaskaran Singh, Manager of M/s Aviator Filling Station (Patrol Pump). Since no physical harm or financial loss was found to have been caused by such accident, the matter was disposed of.

Learned counsel further contends that after two months, an FIR has been registered at the instance of respondent No.5 against unknown persons and under the garb of that FIR, the petitioner is being arrested.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. P.S. Ghuman, Addl, AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition has been supplied to the learned State counsel today in the Court.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing reply as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner in view of her representation filed on 28.02.2017 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
