In the present petition, petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.6 dated 10.01.2005, under Sections 365, 506, 149, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all other accused persons in the said FIR case have been acquitted and therefore, that is the reason why the FIR in question should be quashed qua the present petitioner.

FIR relates to the year 2005 and the petition has been filed in 2017. Even, if other accused persons in the said FIR case have been acquitted that cannot be the reason to record order of acquittal of the petitioner also.

In that view of the matter, the present petition cannot be entertained and stands dismissed. Liberty reserved in favour of the petitioner to participate in the proceedings of the case arising out of

FIR No.6 dated 10.01.2005, under Sections 365, 506, 149, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozep. The petitioner shall cooperate with the trial Court in getting the case decided.
