It may be noticed that even on 11.07.2016 none had appeared and accordingly fresh notice had been issued to the petitioner for 17.08.2016.

As per office report, petitioner had been duly served but despite thereof, there is no representation on his behalf.

It would be apposite to take note that vide order dated 30.09.2014 petitioner was granted concession of interim bail to enable him to amicably settle the matter with the complainant.

Having secured such concession, no such settlement has been arrived at rather petitioner is evading proceedings even in the instant revision petition.

The only inference that can be drawn is that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the petition. The main revision petition is, accordingly,

dismissed.

Even the concession of interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 30.09.2014 passed by this Court shall, accordingly, ceased to operate.
