CRM No. 27362 of 2014 :

In view of the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed. Delay of 13 days in filing the revision petition is condoned.

Main Case :

Present revision petition is against judgment dated 21.5.2014 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur, whereby Dharam Singh-respondent No. 2 was released on probation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that Dharam Singh is the main accused and he should not have been released on probation in this case and order dated 21.5.2014 is liable to be set side.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the considered view that Dharam Singh was convicted and sentenced for commission of offences punishable under

Sections 323, 324, 325 and 34 IPC and considering the provisions of Probation of Offenders Act, the learned Additional Sessions Judge extended the same benefit to Dharam Singh. There is absolutely no illegality in the order under challenge. The present petition is without any merit and accordingly, the same is dismissed.
