RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents for protection of his civil rights from being invaded without following due process of law.

Petitioner was involved in a case under NDPS Act when 4 kgs of poppy husk was allegedly recovered from him in the month of May, 2016. An amount of Rs.2.30 lacs was also alleged to be the amount received on account of illegal sale of poppy husk. Petitioner was granted regular bail in the aforesaid case and thereafter, no other case was registered against the petitioner. In the earlier cases registered against the petitioner, the petitioner was either granted bail or acquitted by the competent Court.

Petitioner prays that the civil rights of the petitioner be protected by directing the official respondents not to raid the house of the petitioner in odd hours without following due

process of law in terms of issuing notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, petitioner has already moved a representation dated 24.01.2017 before respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. P.S. Ghuman, Addl, AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition has been supplied to the learned State counsel today in the Court.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing reply as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner in view of his representation filed on 24.01.2017 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
