A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.0227 dated 25.9.2016, under Sections 381, 120-B, 506 IPC, PS Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 26.4.2017, report of the learned JMIC, Jalandhar has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.

The petitioners have also complied with order dated 26.4.2017 and produced on record a photocopy of the receipt showing the deposit of Rs.50,000/- in favour of Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana with the Govt. Treasury.

In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/ compromise.
