The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.183 dated 01.11.2012, for the offence under Sections 323, 341, 506 IPC (charge under Section 382 IPC also) registered at Police Station Mataur, Mohali along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 09.02.2017 (Annexure P-2).

It was alleged by the complainant that petitioner got married to one Kulwant Kaur without getting divorce from the petitioner. On 10.01.2012 when the complainant was going to her house after attending the hearing of the Civil Suit at District Courts, Mohali, she was about to leave the Court complex, the petitioner came from backside and pushed the petitioner and started beating to the complainant and snatched the gold chain and inflicted injuries on her shoulder and on spinal cord. On this background, the FIR was registered.

During the pendency of the trial, the matter has been resolved between the petitioners and respondent No.2-Jasvir Kaur, vide compromise deed dated 09.02.2017 (Annexure P-2).

In compliance with the order dated 03.03.2017 passed by this Court, the parties got recorded their statements before the trial Court.

**CRM-M-7077 of 2017**

As per report, Jasvir Kaur-complainant and accused-petitioner appeared before the trial Court on 09.05.2017 for getting their statements recorded in support of the compromise. In this regard statements of complainant- Jasvir Kaur and accused-petitioners were recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and Jasvir Kaur-complainant has no objection if the present FIR is quashed against the accused/petitioner. Statements of accused-petitioner were also recorded to the same effect. In view of separate statements of the parties, the Court is satisfied that the compromise is valid and genuine one.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.183 dated 01.11.2012, for the offence under Sections 323, 341, 506 IPC (charge under Section 382 IPC also) registered at Police Station Mataur, Mohali, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
