This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.399 dated 6.10.2016 under sections 379-B, 411 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, A Division, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Amit Sharma, who stated himself to be serving as Area Manager in a Research Medicine company. It is alleged that on the intervening night of 4/5.10.2016 when he was going along with his employee in a rickshaw, they were accosted by four unidentified youth, who were in an auto rickshaw. One of the assailants was stated to be holding a Poker/Sua and under the threat of the same one mobile phone along with SIM card, two A.T.M Cards, Driving License, R.C of motorcycle and an amount of Rs.22,500/- cash were snatched.

The present petitioners are stated to have been implicated on the basis of a secret information and were arrested on 8.10.2016.

As per prosecution version, recovery of mobile phone has been effected from petitioner no.1, whereas A.T.M card and the R.C of motorcycle has been effected from petitioner no.2. That apart, learned State counsel submits that even the auto rickshaw used in the alleged occurrence has been recovered from the joint possession of the petitioners.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has already been presented. Charges are yet to be framed. Trial, as such, would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Petition disposed of.
