Petitioner-Kamla Bai has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.509 dated 10.08.2015, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 467, 468, and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

Complainant has also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as

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learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the complainant has stated that compromise has already been effected in this case.

The petitioner has been in custody since 18.12.2016. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. Now, she has only to face the trial and conclusion of the same will take a long time. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
