The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.5 dated 15.01.2016 registered under Sections 308, 323, 452, 500, 506, 427, 148 read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station Sarai Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran.

On 16.01.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that that the petitioner himself suffered six injuries including one grievous injury as reflected in MLR dated 20.12.2015. The petitioner is the complainant in cross version case. The occurrence took place on 20.12.2015 whereas the FIR was registered on 15.01.2016.

Notice of motion for 01.02.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

To be heard along with CRM-M-45308-2016 ”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 16.01.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 16.01.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
