This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.85 dated 01.07.2016 registered under Sections 307 & 120-B read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Line Paar, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

The petitioner was arrested on 06.07.2016 and since then he is in jail. The challan has been filed before the competent Court. Admittedly, the role attributed to the petitioner that he was driving the car and main accused Rajnish @ Chintu was the person who had committed offence.

Since the petitioner was driving the car it can easily be said that he was also member of the group but then looking to the fact that he

was only found driving the car and ran away and had no role like Rajnish @ Chintu, the petitioner can be released on bail.

Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-7104 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition, the present order shall come to an end and the petitioner shall surrender to the judicial custody.
