Both the petitioners herein are NRIs. Pleadings on record would indicate that a power of attorney had been executed in favour of Baldev Singh i.e. close relative of the petitioners. It is alleged that Baldev Singh respondent No.4 had misused the power of attorney and had transferred the land in question in favour of his wife vide sale deed dated 21.04.2016. Further asserted that a compromise thereafter had been effected and in pursuance to which it was agreed that a civil suit would be filed and in which Baldev Singh as also the beneficiary, namely, Manjeet Kaur would give a statement and the sale deed would be declared as illegal, null and void.

The grievance put forth in this petition is that as per compromise, the civil suit has been filed but respondent No.4 by exercising his influence and in connivance with respondent No.3 who is a SHO, Police Station Raikot, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, the petitioners are being harassed and threatened so as to pressurize them to withdraw the civil proceedings.

Against such backdrop, protection of life and liberty of the petitioners has been sought.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine a representation dated 03.02.2017 (Annexure P-3) that is stated to have already been filed and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
