By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.168 dated 02.11.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Ambala, District Ambala, Haryana.

On 15.03.2017, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is complainant in another FIR No.0142 dated 18.11.2015, registered at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Ambala against one Manish Patyal. The present FIR has been registered at the behest of said Manish Patyal to dissuade and prohibit the petitioner to pursue his case against another travel agent.

Post again on 09.05.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2.That he shall not directly or indirectly

*make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court”*

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 15.03.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.03.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
