As per Registry, costs of ₹3,000/- has been deposited in the Legal Services Committee of this Court vide receipt No.17 dated 01.05.2017.

Petitioner-Naresh Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.937 dated 23.12.2016, registered at Police Station Jagadhari City, District Yamuna Nagar, under Section 174-A IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that FIR has been registered under Section 174-A IPC. In pursuance of the order dated 06.03.2017, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 06.03.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
