By way of filing the instant revision petition, the petitioners have laid challenge to order dated 05.08.2014, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, thereby, framing charge against the accused-petitioners in FIR No.205 dated 08.08.2013, registered under Sections 365, 328, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Vide separate judgment/order of even date, passed in CRM-M-27166-2017, the FIR in question and all subsequent proceedings flowing therefrom, have been quashed on the basis of compromise reached between the parties, rendering the instant revision petition infructuous.
