Petitioner-Nisha has filed this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.116 dated 20.07.2015, registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier petition of present petitioner for anticipatory bail was got dismissed as withdrawn by the petitioner vide order dated 14.07.2016 passed by this Court. Now no change in circumstances has been shown to this Court for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

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As per the prosecution version, the petitioner is one of the partners in Bajrang Bali Rice Mills, village Dholra, Tehsil Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar. There are allegations that the partners of the aforesaid firm had misappropriated the rice 8368.46 quintals.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
