Pursuant to the order dated 08.03.2017, learned State counsel has produced in Court today a communication received in the Office of the Advocate General, Haryana, from the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, stating to the effect that the daughter of the petitioner is not residing at the address given in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced in Court today a prescription issued by a *Private Nursing Home in Hisar* showing that Kaavya, who is stated to be the daughter of the petitioner, was undergoing some treatment for a respiratory problem and other problems. The last prescription/diagnosis slip is dated 05.02.2017.

He further submits that, in any case, no offence punishable under Sections 370 and 388 IPC, would be made out against the petitioner, as Section 370 IPC pertains to immoral trafficking by a person, who recruits, transports, harbours, transfers or receives a person towards such purpose and against the petitioner in any case there is no allegation to that effect at all.

As regards Section 388 IPC, there is no complaint at all against the petitioner to the effect that she attempted any extortion or made a threat against any person.

Keeping in view the cumulative circumstances and the fact that even the charge has not been framed as yet, with the co-accused of the petitioner not being produced by the jail authorities for two dates in succession, as per the zimni orders produced by petitioner's counsel in Court today, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail, also keeping in view her age, i.e. 20 years, upon her furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
