Petitioner-Sukhchain Singh alias Sony has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.27 dated 23.01.2014, registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar City, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In pursuance of the order dated 08.03.2017, this Court has received the medical report of the petitioner. As per the same, the

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present petitioner is suffering from Hepatitis C and Epilepsy, which are both chronic diseases. Both the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class.

The petitioner has been in custody since 03.06.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the health of the petitioner, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
