The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 288 dated 03.12.2016 registered under Sections 420, 411 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana.

On 03.03.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Contends that the petitioner is neither recipient of any amount nor issued/prepared any cheque or draft in favour of the complainant. The transaction, if any, is between the husband of the petitioner-Santosh Kumar and the complainant.

Notice of motion for 24.04.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the

Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 03.03.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
