The present petition has been filed under Section 438
the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 256 dated
15.12.2016 registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC at Police Station
Nakodar, District Jalandhar Rural.

On 03.03.2017 this Court had passed the following
order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the alleged transaction took
place on 10.11.2013 whereas the FIR was registered on
15.12.2016. He further contends that the complainant in fact is
a commission agent.

Notice of motion for 24.04.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the

Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 03.03.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 03.03.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
