DARSHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is for the issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5. The petitioners contend that they being major, have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. They further submit that respondents No.4 and 5 are not accepting their marriage and adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. They further submit that in view of the imminent danger to their lives and liberty, the petitioners had already moved a representation (Annexure P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the matter, but without

going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to take action as warranted by law on the representation moved by the petitioners and in the meantime, to issue necessary orders to ensure that no harm is caused to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.
