On asking of the Court, Mr. Jasjeet Dhaliwal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

After hearing arguments at length for some time and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to ensure that neither the petitioners nor any of their family members are put to unnecessary harassment at the behest of private respondents No.5 to 9 and to take prompt and expeditious action on the complaint and representation i.e. Annexures P-3 and P-5, respectively moved by the petitioners and also to ensure due protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioners and their family members by all means as well as to ensure that the investigations are accomplished preferably within

a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that in case of subsequent grievances having legitimately arisen to the petitioners, they are well within their rights to invoke jurisdiction of this Court on the same very grounds afresh, within the framework of law.
