Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 22.07.2014 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Zira, whereby respondent No.2 was discharged in case FIR No.163 dated 29.08.2012 under Sections 509 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

On a specific query as regards the maintainability of the present revision petition against the order dated 22.07.2014 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Zira discharging the accused, learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly conceded that there is a remedy available to the petitioner to impugn the order of discharge before the Court of Sessions. He prays for withdrawal of the revision petition, however submits that in case petitioner prefers a revision petition before the Court of Sessions, the delay in filing revision may be condoned.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

As the petitioner has been pursuing the present revision before this Court under a bonafide belief, in case petitioner prefers a revision petition before the Court of Sessions within a month from today, the limitation shall not come in his way.
