Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No. 121 dated 25.11.2016, registered at Police Station Women, Yamuna Nagar, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 365, 376, 452 and 506 IPC.

Petitioner is in custody since 25.11.2016 and seeking grant of regular bail. The complainant is a widow who lost her husband on 25.10.2013 and as per the FIR, she was known to the petitioner for the last 10-12 years and she had friendly relationship with him.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kamla, informed that the complaint was made on 07.11.2016 whereas the marriage was fixed for 06.11.2016 and the charges have been framed. Keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude and the fact that the complainant has turned hostile, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail

during pendency of the trial of the present case, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.
