The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the FIR No.174 dated 26.12.2016, under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel would vehemently contend that the petitioners are in fact the victims and private respondent No.2 Hardip Singh is intent upon falsely implicating the petitioners.

Concededly, the matter is still at the stage of investigation.

At this stage, Mr. K.S.Dadwal, learned counsel submits that he would not be pressing the instant petition qua the main relief for quashing of the FIR but would be satisfied if directions are to be issued to the Investigating Agency to even look into the complaint/documents placed on record at Annexures P-2, P-3, P-5 and P-6 as such documents as per counsel would have a relevant bearing on the case and would aid towards a fair investigation.

In the light of such limited prayer made by counsel, this Court

does not feel the need of issuing notice and eliciting a response from the respondent party.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1/Investigating Agency to even examine the complaint/documents at Annexures P-2, P-3, P-5 and P-6 placed on record while investigating the matter as regards the impugned FIR.

It is, however, clarified that such directions have been given without going into the merits of the case and without expressing any opinion with regard to relevance of such documents. It would be open for the Investigating Agency to take an independent view with regard to relevance of complaint/documents at Annexures P-2, P-3, P-5 and P-6 in the matter.

Petition disposed of.
