Petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.207 dated 13.10.2016 under Sections 420, 467, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Sunita Chauhan wife of Rajinder Singh. She alleged that on account of illness of her husband and busy schedule of his sons, they could not look after the land qua which fake documentation was done by the accused persons by mis-using the name and previous address of the complainant. Fake ration card was prepared by duplicate Sunita Chauhan wherein name of her son was also shown as Abhishek Chauhan. The address of the

complainant was also mis-used. Copy of Jamabandi and Girdawaries were also issued on the name of Harkesh in respect of the land in connivance with Niranjn Singh and Halqa Patwari Sanjay Brar. Aadhar card and voter cards were also prepared on the said address.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and he is sought to be arrested solely on the basis of disclosure statement of Niranjn Singh who has already been granted anticipatory bail. The alleged documents were never used in any transaction. The alleged forgery was only at the stage of preparation and was never attempted in translating the act.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh submitted that Halqa Patwari Sanjay Brar has already been joined in the investigation. Since, the offence is triable by Magistrate, petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.01.2017, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jagadhri.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
