This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case 'Crime No. 44' dated 20.10.2016, registered at Police Station NCB Zonal Unit, Chandigarh, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 8, 21, 23, 29 and 60 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Pursuant to the order dated 16.03.2017, Mr. D.D.Sharma, learned standing counsel for the respondent, does not dispute the fact that the quantity of contraband stated to have been recovered from the petitioner is non-commercial and that no other case is seen to be registered against him.

Consequently, in view of the fact that the petitioner has already been in custody for the past more than 05 months and only one witness out of 14 has been examined, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
