The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.157 dated 25.09.2016 registered under Section 323, 452, 506, 307 & 34 IPC at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested on 20.09.2016 and since then he is in jail. The challan has been filed. The trial has commenced. The material witness namely the injured-victim has been examined. I have perused the examination-in-chief as well as cross-examination of injured victim (PW-2) as shown by learned counsel for the petitioner. Upon perusal of the deposition I am satisfied that prima facie the petitioner is entitled to the relief of regular bail.

Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

(i) CRL. MISC. No.M-7408 OF 2017 is allowed. ...2

- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition, the present order shall come to an end and the petitioner shall surrender to the judicial custody.
