Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.330 dated 19.09.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 341, 201, 148, 149, 120-B of Indian Penal Code (Section 308 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Prabhjot Singh in relation to an occurrence that took place on 17.09.2016. Main accused in the case is Amritpal Singh Sekhon. Present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the disclosure statement of main accused.

As per prosecution version, present petitioner was allegedly armed with a baseball bat and had inflicted an injury on the person of Balwinder Singh and which hit him on the knee joint of right leg. Such injury after conducting of an x-ray has been declared to be grievous in nature.

Investigation in the case is complete. Challan already stands

presented. Trial would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail. Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
