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Petitioner-Ravinder alias Kala has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.710 dated 20.08.2016, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the petitioner has been named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with pistol and fire-arm injury has been attributed to him. He is the main accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought into notice of this Court that complainant as well as injured have appeared before the Court and their statements have been placed on record. PW 3 Amit (injured) has specifically deposed that the accused persons present in the Court are not the same, who assaulted him and fired upon him. PW 2 Dheeraj has also deposed the same facts. PW 4 Ashok has totally turned hostile.

Otherwise also, the petitioner has been in custody since 22.08.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of

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₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
